Unit Information Sheet

Product is a Clint and Sons Beef stick 1.1 oz. Twice the size of last year's small stick!

Sell 1 stick for \$2.00 (30 sticks per box)

Commission is split half for the unit, half for the Council after Council pays for the boxes.

Once the sale is over, turn in unused "Full Boxes" that are deemed "re-sellable". No torn or marked up boxes will be accepted. You will receive an invoice for your breakdown of funds. See example below:

Unit sells 10 boxes x \$60.00 retail	\$600.00	
Council pays RC Taylor for product	<u>- \$250.00</u>	(\$25.00 x 10)
Remainder	= \$350.00	

Council and Unit split \$350.00 for \$175.00 each. (29.16% of \$600.00)

Clint and Sons is a Texas panhandle company in Whitedeer, Texas. It has been in production since 1944.

The beef stick is larger than last year's Jack Links by twice the size (.5 oz. vs 1.1 oz.)
