OUR SCOUTS AND VOLUNTEERS COLLECTED OVER 40,000 LBS OF FOOD DURING OUR ANNUAL SCOUTING FOR FOOD DRIVE. IN ADDITION, OUR SCOUTS PROVIDED OVER 3,000 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE IN 2019.

Finances

The South Plains Council operated with a positive balance by realizing a net excess in revenue over expenses. Donations from individuals remained steady through fundraising efforts despite a challenging economic environment. Family and community support through Friends of Scouting, popcorn sales, and special events remain strong.

Membership

The South Plains Council served 1,556 Cub Scouts, 531 Scouts BSA, and 85 Venturers & Explorers for a total of 2,172 youth in 76 units. We had 26 Scouts earn the rank of Eagle, and 56 Webelos earn the Arrow of Light.

Camp Usage

In 2019, Camp Post and Camp Tres Ritos conducted a full three week camping season. Over <mark>300</mark> registered Scouts BSA attended long-term summer camp. Camp Post had over <mark>336</mark> Cubs Scouts and their families attend our Fall Cub Camp.
